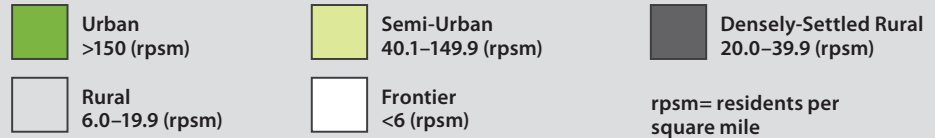
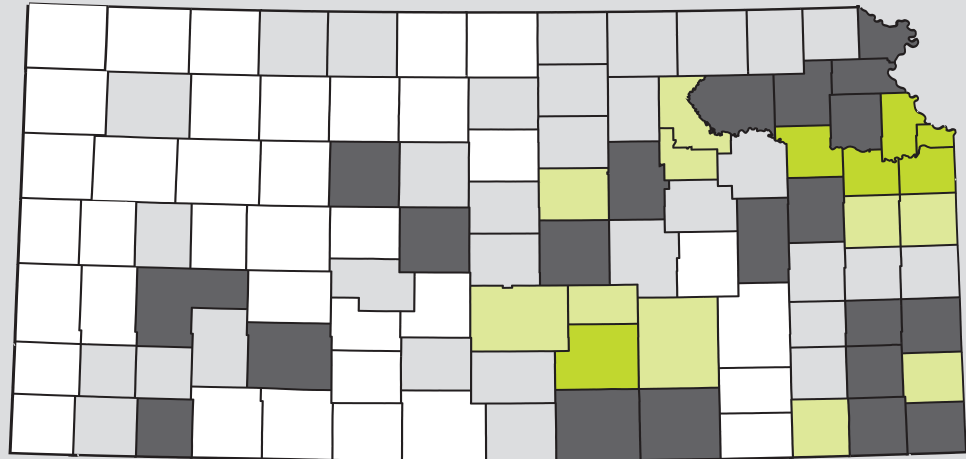

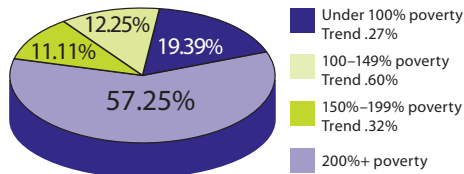

Poverty status of Kansas children under 18.

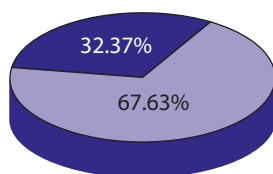

Home ownership among Kansas families with children under 18.

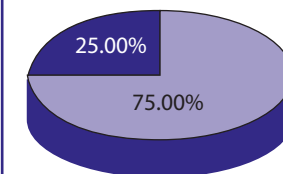


Percent of households with children under 18 who do not own their home

Employment status of Kansas parents with children under 18.

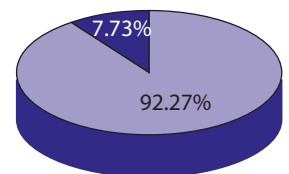


Percent of children with no parent working 35+ hours a week for 50 weeks
